Professor Jason W. Brown, MD.

Jason Brown is Professor of Neurology at the New York University Medical Center (NYU) and Visiting Scholar of the Psychoanalytic Institute, New York. He has held numerous research fellowships in Boston, Paris, Bucharest, Moscow, and Bonn.

Professor Brown has published numerous books and articles on brain research, psychoanalysis, the philosophy of mind, and other areas of related interest, including *Mind, Brain and Consciousness* (1977), *Life of the Mind* (1988), *Time, Will and Mental Process* (1996); *The Self-Embodying Mind* (2002), *Process and the Authentic Life* (2005), *Love and other Emotions* (2012), *Gourmet's Guide to the Mind*, and due soon, *Microgenetic Theory and Process Thought*.

For his lifetime achievement in creating and developing the microgenetic theory of brain-mind function, Jason Brown was awarded the Copernicus Prize 2003 by the Polish Neuropsychological Society. This is his nine lecture in Poland.
